

The Elf on the Shelf® Holiday Ribbon Tree







The North Pole is filled with hundreds of these beautiful ribbon trees - the elves have been making them in all colors and sizes! This fun and easy DIY decor project is a great way to decorate your home for the holidays.

You'll Need:

- · Ribbon, in various colors of your choice
- T-pins
- Scissors
- Craft foam cone in size of your choice
- Craft glue
- * Please enjoy creating this activity with an adult's help as it uses sharp pins.

Instructions:

- 1. Cut various colors of ribbon into small pieces, about 3-4 inches long. The thickness of your ribbon and the size of your craft foam cone will determine how many pieces you will need to cut in order to complete the tree.
- 2. Take one piece of ribbon and fold it in half creating a loop; pushing a T-pin through the two loose ends of the ribbon, pin it to the craft foam cone. It is best to start at the base of the cone, placing each ribbon loop next to the previous one, and working your way up. Use different ribbon colors to create the pattern of your choice. Be sure to hide the pins in the lower rows with the ribbon loops from the row above.
- 3. Wrap a piece of ribbon around the top of the cone to hide the ribbon edges of the top row, and secure with a pin.
- **4.** Glue a bow to the top of the tree as the finishing touch!
