

RAZZLE MEDAL CEREMONY

Imagine your child waking up to find your Scout Elf and Razzle together at a celebration ceremony with medals, a shiny trophy, or even stickers ready to go. They may even add a sign: "Today we celebrate YOU!"

Materials:

- Razzle the Snowman Book and Plush
- Printable medal/trophy
- ribbon for medal
- tape or glue to adhere medal
- stickers (optional)
- candies (optional)



Instructions:

- 1. Razzle and your Scout Elf team up to create this special moment! They will print out a medal or trophy and write in what your child is being celebrated for. They might even glue the medal to a long ribbon so it can be worn proudly around their neck—just like a real champion.
- 2. Kids can receive medals or trophies for small or big wins—showing kindness, trying something new, brushing teeth without a reminder, or performing in a school play.
- 3. Parents will help Razzle and their Scout Elf hold a celebration ceremony with claps and cheers.

Why it matters: Celebrating effort (not just big achievements) teaches resilience and builds self-esteem. Children learn that progress is worth recognizing, even in small steps.

Extra Tip: Your Scout Elf might present the medal while Razzle offers up additional celebratory gifts like stickers or candies.
