

## Scout Elf Squad Search and Rescue

### **Episode Summary:**

When a fox cub goes missing in a snowy storm, the Scout Elf Squad teams up with Noorah to search the North Pole. Preschoolers see how staying calm, thinking clearly, and working together can help solve big challenges.

#### Core social-emotional learning themes:

Teamwork, bravery, problem-solving, co-regulation (staying calm together)

#### Vocabulary & feelings:

- · Brave, careful, plan, safe place, help, proud
- Prompt: "Show me your 'I did it!' face."

#### Connect to skills:

- Self-management: breathing & waiting;
- Social awareness: noticing others' needs;
- Relationship skills: asking for/accepting help;
- Responsible decision-making: choosing a safe plan.

#### **Episode Touchpoints**

- The Squad notices storm clouds, takes deep breaths together, and finds a safe plan.
- They coordinate tools (Detecto-Specs, Zazzle-Wand, Blasto-Board, Magic Gadget) to help a worried fox cub reunite with Noorah.

#### Talk & reflect (after viewing):

- "What did the elves do first when the weather felt scary?" (Name calm-down steps and safe choices.)
- "How did each elf help?" (Spot strengths: noticing, planning, helping, being brave.)
- "When do we work as a team at home?"

#### Try-it-together activities:

- Calm-down practice (co-regulation): "Snow Breaths": Inhale through the nose for 3 (smell hot cocoa), exhale for 4 (blow snowflakes). Use before transitions.
- Plan-the-rescue play: Role-play helping a stuffed animal down from a high spot safely. Take turns being each elf. (Labels strengths; rehearses asking for
- Team jobs chart: Create 2-3 simple family "rescue" jobs (Finder, Helper, Checker) for clean-up or getting out the door. Rotate daily.

#### Interaction questions

- What did the Scout Elf Squad build for Santa's Snow Statue Extravaganza? (Helps with recall and naming details)
- Who needed help in this episode? (Supports recognizing characters and empathy)
- Where did the elves search for the missing fox cub? (Encourages spatial awareness and story sequencing—forest, pond, hills)
- Why did the elves work together instead of searching alone? (Builds) understanding of teamwork and cooperative problem-solving)
- How did the Scout Elf Squad stay calm during the storm? (Strengthens) emotional awareness and self-regulation skills)
